Your privacy is important to us.

The Enercon Group takes its responsibility to make commercially reasonable steps to maintain security and protect your privacy seriously.

Enercon will not sell, lease or rent your information to third parties.

Terms and conditions of use

This Privacy Policy describes the conditions under which the Enercon Group which includes Enercon Technologies Ltd., Enercon Technologies Europe AG., Multisphere Power Solutions, Mil Power Magnetics India Private Limited, Mil Power Converter Technologies India Private Limited, Techaya Ltd. and Elcatech Development Ltd. (together or separately: "the Company" or "we") use personal information that we collect, receive and store about individuals in connection with the use of (i) the following websites: www.enercon.co.il, www.enercon-europe.com and www.techaya.com (together with their portal, pages, sub-domains and content, the "Website"); (ii) any services we provide (e.g., support services, the "Services"); and (iii) products we sell or provide ("Products"). This Privacy Policy forms part of our terms of use for the Website, and the terms and conditions for the license, sale and use of any of our Services or Products (collectively, "Terms").

We strongly recommend that you read the Privacy Policy carefully.

You are not legally obligated to provide us your information, and you hereby confirm that you do so at your own free will. By using the Website and/or the Services, you agree to be bound by the terms of the Privacy Policy and to our collection, processing, and sharing of your information for the purposes set forth herein. If you do not accept the terms and conditions of the Privacy Policy, you are directed to discontinue accessing or otherwise using the Website, any related materials and the applicable Services. The Company retains the right without advance notice to modify the terms of this Privacy Policy. Such change will be effective ten (10) days following posting of the revised Privacy Policy on the Website. Information collected

We do not currently require you to provide Personal Information in order to have access to general information available on certain portions of the Website, except as set forth below. We do receive and/or collect Personal Information from you in the following ways:

<u>'Contact Us' Information</u>. <u>Log Files</u>. We may make use of log files. The information inside the log files includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, type of browser, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date/time stamp, referring/exit pages, clicked pages and any other information your browser may send to us. We may use such information to analyze trends, diagnose problems with our servers, administer the Services and the Website, track users' movement around the Services, identify you for the duration of a session and gather demographic information.

<u>Clickstream Data</u>. As you browse the Internet, a trail of electronic information is left at each website you visit. This information, which is sometimes called "clickstream" data, can be collected and stored by a web site's server. Clickstream data can tell us the type of computer and browsing software you use, the address of the website from which you linked to the Website, and in some instances, your e-mail address. Information Use

If you submit or we collect Personal Information through the Website, Services or Products, then we may, in addition to the uses described above, use such Personal Information as following:

- 1. Please note that even if you opt out of receiving the foregoing emails, we may still send you a response to any "Contact Us" request as well as administrative emails (for example, in connection with a password reset request) that are necessary to facilitate your use of the Website or Services.
- 3. To charge you or collect payment for Products and Services you have ordered or to provide you with a price quote for a Product or Service.
- 4. We store the data in order to create, maintain and develop our customer relations, to market our products and services and to gain a better understanding about the needs of our present and potential customers and business partners.
- 5. We may add you as a contact to our LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram accounts. If you do not agree, you may remove us from your social network accounts at any time.
- 6. We may use Anonymous Information or disclose it to third party service providers in order to improve our Products or Services and enhance your experience with our Products and Services. We may also disclose Anonymous Information (with or without compensation) to third parties, including advertisers and partners. "Anonymous Information" means information which does not enable identification of an individual user, such as aggregated information about the use of our Services.

- 7. We may process your Personal Information for profiling of our customers for marketing and sales processes.
- 8. Transfer your Personal Information to our local or foreign subsidiaries or affiliated companies for the purpose of storing or processing such information on our behalf. Such information may be transferred to other countries (including without limitation, the U.S.). We require that these parties agree to process such information in compliance with our Privacy Policy.

Information Sharing

We will not rent, sell, transfer, share or disclose Personal Information about you with unaffiliated third parties without your prior written consent, except for sharing your Personal Information with our third-party agents, contractors, business partners, or other service providers as needed service for the sole purpose of such third parties assisting us with our business operations and to provide our Services to you and other users. Such service providers may include IT suppliers (e.g., cloud-based services suppliers), Website servers or design suppliers, Marketing agencies etc. We use commercially reasonable efforts to only engage or interact with third party service providers and partners that post a privacy policy governing their processing of Personal Information, to limit the information provided to service providers to that which is reasonably necessary for them to perform their functions, and to require them to agree to maintain the confidentiality of such information and to comply with applicable data privacy legislation.

Your information may be transferred into or out of your country of residence. We will make efforts to ensure that data transfers georgical under requirements of applicable laws.

We may disclose your Personal Information or any information you submitted via our Website or otherwise if we have a good faith belief that disclosure of such information is helpful or reasonably necessary to: (i) comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request; (ii) enforce our Terms, including investigations of potential violations thereof; (iii) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud or security issues; (iv) protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of the Company, our users, yourself or the public; (v) In the event that we are acquired by or merged with a third-party entity, or in the event of bankruptcy or a comparable event, we reserve the right to transfer or assign Personal Information in connection with the foregoing events.

Choices

At all times, you may choose whether or not to provide or disclose Personal Information. Data Subject Rights

If the data protection legislation which applies to you, includes additional data subject rights, including the right to request additional information about data collection, right to request information about sales and disclosures and the right not to be discriminated against for exercising CCPA rights, you may exercise those by addressing us as aforesaid.

All verifiable Users requests will be handled within the timeframe and subject to exceptions set under the applicable law.

Children's Privacy

Children (persons under the age of 16) are not eligible to use this Website unsupervised, and we ask that children do not submit any Personal Information to us.
